## Calculating your GPA

List your courses and how many credit hours (CH) each one is, then write the letter of your grade goal. Use the following scale to equate the grade value (GV): $A=4 \quad B=3 \quad C=2 \quad D=1 \quad F=0$

To determine the quality points (QP) you'll earn, multiply $C H \times G V=Q P$ for each class. Lastly, divide total QPs by total CHs to determine what your GPA would be, based on your grade goals.

Example: 46 QPs / 13 CHs = 3.5 GPA
