


Remember that being flexible and open to new foods will make your summer even more memorable. Why not take the opportunity to try the classic French dish of escargot or foie gras at a cafe?

The architecture of the store is art nouveau, with a remarkable dome and a panoramic view of Paris that has made it a tourist attraction of the French capital city. Be sure to visit the rooftop terrace for yet another amazing view of the city!

Another absolute must while in France is steak-frites (steak and fries). Visit this steakhouse for one of the best in the city (and for free seconds!). A bit pricier (40 euros, but the taste makes it worth the splurge!
