WHAT IS PRIVATEER PATHWAYS?

Privateer Pathways is designed for students who, because of their ACT or SAT scores, need additional support in mathematics or English. With academic support, students will develop skills necessary to succeed in college and beyond.

Once admitted to the university, Pathways students are placed in learning communities. What does this mean? Pathways students have classes together, for their first two semesters Freshman year. So Pathways students not only receive faculty support, but peer academic support as well. With all the support and guidance Pathways students receive, they can surpass previous academic achievement, and cultivate leadership skills and extracurricular involvement.

You are admitted as a Privateer Pathways student when your test scores are as follows:

Note: A student can only be either a math Pathways student or an English Pathways student.

NEED TO BOOST YOUR SCORE?

The ACCUPLACER is an untimed, computerized test, which helps your eligibility for admission to the university. You receive ACCUPLACER test results immediately after completion. Once you receive your test scores, please bring them to the Privateer Enrollment Center located on the first floor of the Earl K. Long Library. If your score is high enough, you can test out of Privateer Pathways. // Cost: \$20 per section

HOW DO I APPLY?

1. Submit the UNO Online Application
Visit apply.uno.edu to apply
2. Submit the application fee
 - a. Through the UNO online application
 - b. At the Privateer Enrollment Center
 - c. Through an official application fee waiver
3. Submit official High School transcripts
 - a. In-state students: please include your social security number (SSN) when filing out your application. This will allow UNO to receive your transcripts electronically.
 - b. Out-of-state students: please have your high school submit official transcripts to the Office of Admissions by mail.
 - c. Include both completed and in-progress coursework.
4. Submit official test scores from testing agency
Request for your ACT, SAT, Next-Generation ACCUPLACER and/or ACCUPLACER scores to be sent directly from the testing agency.



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WILL I GRADUATE ON TIME?

Yes, you will graduate on time. Pathways students take the same courses as non-Pathways students. The only difference is that Pathways students get the extra support they need in either English or math built into their semester schedules. Both Pathways and non-Pathways students generally enroll in 12-16 credit hours their first semester.

WILL I STILL HAVE FUN?

Yes, oh yes, you will still have fun...balanced between class! Pathways students learn together, so you will have a built-in social support network. When in doubt, set up a meeting with your Pathways Program mentor.

GET A HEADSTART AT PATHWAYS CAMP

All admitted Pathways freshmen have the option to voluntarily attend Pathways Camp, where you prep for freshman year before it starts. Pathways Camp offers one-on-one time with professors, advisers and mentors. You will also get the opportunity to meet key University staff before starting classes in the fall, participate in academic enrichment sessions in math and English, learn time management and study strategies, and engage in leadership building activities. Finally, the best part of Pathways Camp is that you will get to know UNO's campus while building enduring friendships with your peers.
