Quorum was established for undergraduate and graduate voting.

The meeting minutes from the 11-11-19 along with pending proposals were reviewed and voted upon via the UCCC Moodle page. They will be posted to the UCCC website.

The AVIA course proposals will remained tabled until additional information is provided from the College of Business.

Math Undergraduate Certificate – The committee would like a footnote that explains the prerequisites for Math 2314 since it is the first course in the sequence.

FIN 6310 - The committee felt that the description came across more like a justification as to why the course is being created rather than a description of the course itself. The course lists FIN 3300 as a prereq. Enrollment can be restricted degree program or by department consent. There were also concerns that the student learning outcomes seemed more appropriate for a 5000 level rather than a 6000-level course.

IDS Proposals – IDS 1002, the bibliography and the grading scale are missing from the syllabus.

IDS 2001 – Due to the significant change in the title and the course description, the committee is recommending that the department actually create a new course rather than change 2001. Additionally, this would require an update to the IDS Curriculum Change proposal.

MANG 4450/5450 – The bibliographies were missing. There were concerns as to whether PLUS or POLI departments were consulted due to the potential overlap in content. The Minor in Disaster Management and Community Resilience is referenced and there is a graduate certificate offered by PLUS in conjunction with POLI. In the SLOs for 5450, it gives the assignments for the graduate students rather than the actual learning outcomes.

Math 4410/5410 – The bibliographies are missing. MATH 3511 cannot serve a prereq for 5410. Enrollment can be restricted degree program or by department consent. The committee wanted clarification regarding the homework requirements for graduate students.

CSCI 6452 - 4401 and 4311 cannot be prereqs for this course. Enrollment can be restricted degree program or by department consent.
